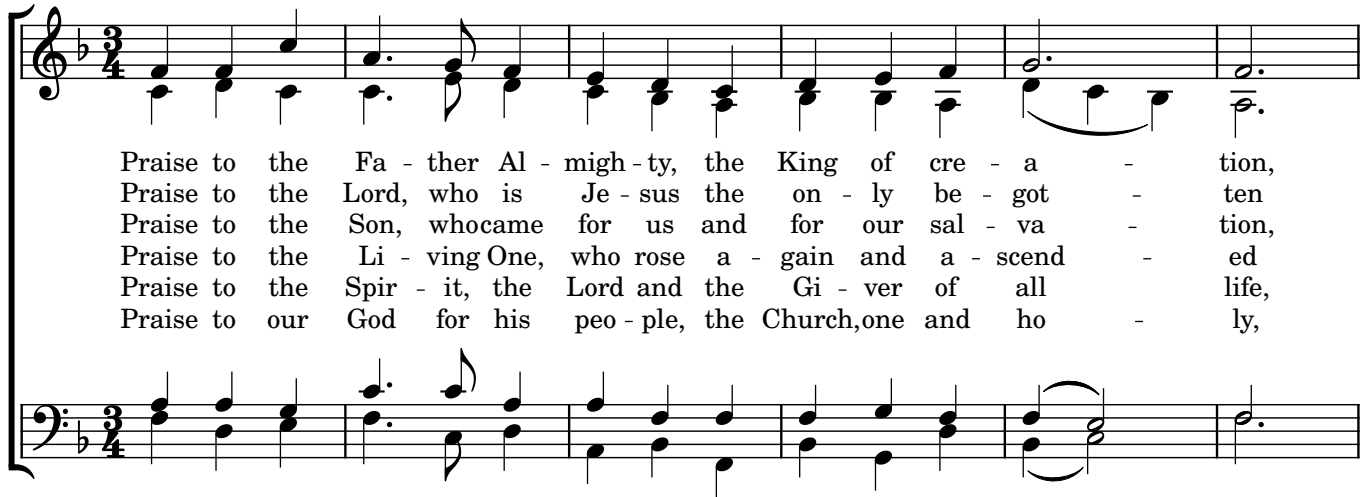

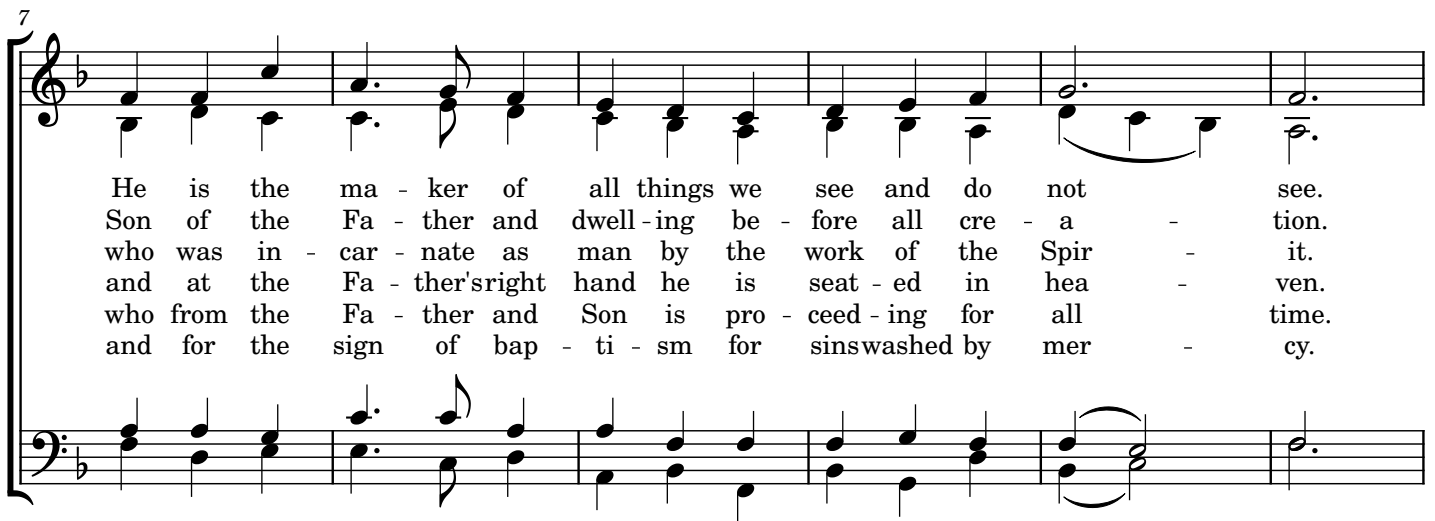

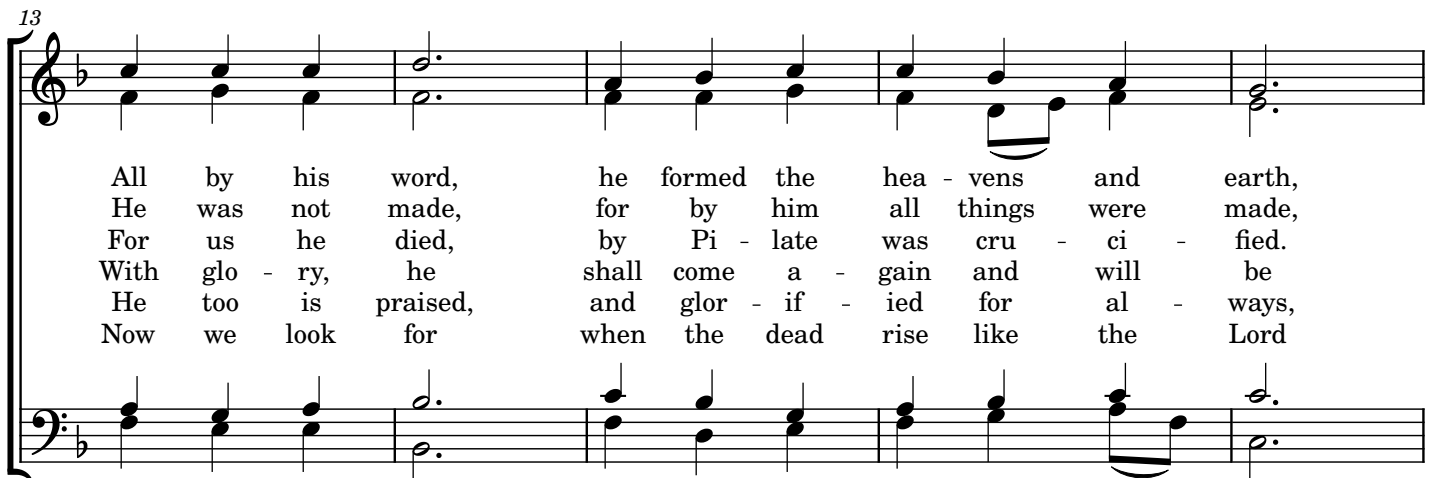
Praise to the Fa - ther Al - migh - ty, the King of cre - a - tion,
